#### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities of the Position**

- Provide coaching and technical support in the use of both hardware and software.
- Work with teachers individually and in groups on the integration of technology in lesson planning through curriculum and pedagogy.
- Coordinate with outside vendors, consultants, and trainers on the implementation and training of new software and hardware.
- Provide staff development on technology resources including use of applications and equipment; maintenance; general troubleshooting; previewing, evaluating, and selecting software; etc.
- Design individual instructional modules, instructional materials, and training aides.
- Assess participant acquisition of skills using a variety of evaluation procedures.
- Share effective technical and instructional strategies with teachers for the effective use of technology in the classroom.
- Provide classroom technology instruction and support for teachers and students within the scope and sequence of classroom curriculum.
- Assist teachers and staff in planning for the effective implementation of technology within the curriculum to ensure that the appropriate technology is used to meet student needs.
- Research, evaluate, and implement new technology-based resources to support the instructional and administrative processes.
- Manage the technology orientation of new campus staff.
- Assist with the technology orientation of incoming freshmen and transfer students.
- Attend Diocesan level Instructional Technology meetings.
- Establish and maintain positive interactions with all client groups; to include students, faculty, staff, and parents.

- Participate in training/continuing education to maintain knowledge of and skills with current technologies.
- Coordinate the communication of campus, diocesan, state, and federal technology policies and procedures and work to ensure compliance by students, faculty, and staff.
- Assist with detection and resolution of software application and hardware problems.
- Serve as liaison to outside vendors that provide support for technology equipment and materials.
- Assist principal(s) and campus committees with planning of technology training, implementation of technology plans, and selection of technology equipment and software.
- Attend instructional workshops as is required.
- Assist in budgeting and monitoring campus technology expenditures.
- Monitor use of purchased software and hardware and make decisions about the value of investment in the product.
- Assists the staff and faculty in the development of student programs and services.
- Provide client support and technical issue resolution via E-Mail, phone and other electronic medium.
- Other duties as assigned.
